German Roach Preparation Sheet

Thank you for choosing Perseverance Pest Control! German Roaches multiply very fast and can be very difficult to control and eradicate without your help! We have developed a special checklist for our customers to complete during and after the treatment process. We ask that you please review this worksheet and complete all items listed. When this checklist is followed we have discovered that not only are our treatments faster and more effective, but it also costs our customers less time and money in the long run.

- Empty out all kitchen and bathroom cabinets, both upper and lower cabinets.
- Empty out all drawers in kitchen and bathroom.
- Remove all small appliances from the counter tops. Large microwaves and ovens can stay where they are.
- Clean all appliances, countertops, cabinets, Drawers and kitchen/bathroom floors with soap and hot water.
- Place all items from the cabinets on the kitchen table or in the center of the living room floor and cover with a sheet, blanket or plastic tarp.
- Your P.P.C. Technician will pull the refrigerator, dishwasher, and stove away from the wall to treat underneath and behind them so please remove any items that might be on top of them so they won't fall when moved.
- Vacuum all floors making sure to get really good around the baseboards, this will help with getting the roach eggs. Also vacuum the edges of the cabinets, and drawers for elimination of the eggs.
- Do not keep any unopened food out during treatment and place unopened food on table or middle off the living room and cover with sheet, blanket, or plastic tarp.

Please, be prepared and ready when the technician arrives. And please be prepared to be GONE FROM YOUR HOME FOR A MINIMUM OF 3 (THREE) HOURS OR UNTIL CHEMICAL IS COMPLETELY DRY. Please make sure ALL PETS, PEOPLE WITH BREATHING ISSUES, AND CHILDREN DO NOT RE-ENTER BEFORE ANOTHER PERSON MAKES SURE IT IS DRY AND FREE OF ODORS.

After Treatment:

- After re-entry, make sure to clean all surfaces which will come in contact with food, and clean off bottom surfaces of cabinets.
- Vacuum up any visible dead roaches every day.
- Please do not leave any food, trash, grease or beverages out at night. Clean sanitation practices are important in order to completely eliminate roach infestations.

A follow up treatment for the Cockroaches will be scheduled about 12 days after the initial service. If you have any questions regarding your follow up appointment please speak with your technician or contact our office.
